

# **GUIDELINES ON THE CREAM FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME (CFP)**

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The CREAM Fellowship Programme provides an opportunity for researchers and academics to share their professional thoughts and ongoing, or recently completed, research at CREAM. CREAM accepts applications year-round, but selections will be made on a quarterly basis.

The program offers fellows the opportunity to learn about:

- Advanced construction materials
- Digitalisation/construction technology
- Sustainability and resilience
- IBS
- Affordable housing
- Structural and forensic engineering
- Railway engineering
- · Socio and economics studies in the construction industry / built environment
- Productivity

The benefits of the programme are:

- Bridging the gap between academia/scholars and industry;
- Offering networking opportunities for local and international industry players; and
- Penetrating the industry market through commercialised potential products.

#### 2.0 ELIGIBILITY

Candidates must meet the following criteria:

- Open for International and Malaysian candidates;
- The minimum age is 40 years old;
- Have a minimum PhD or its equivalent in related fields;
- Have a reputable ongoing research grant on a topic of relevance to CREAM; and
- Have outstanding research achievements and be internationally recognised.

#### 3.0 APPLICATION

Applications should be sent to <u>fellowship@cream.my</u> and should include the following:

- Cover letter;
- Curriculum Vitae (CV);
- Short description of an ongoing related research project(s) including objective(s) of the study, methodology, and findings; and
- Presentation materials such as slides in PowerPoint (max 10 slides).

## 4.0 SELECTION

A Fellowship Selection Committee (FSC), chaired by the CEO of CREAM, will review applications and make the final selection.

There are two selection methods under the program:

- Competitive selection: Applications will be evaluated based on the applicant's background and expertise, as well as the quality of research and its relevance to CREAM.
- Direct selection: This modality will be used in special cases where the committee deems it necessary to engage specific individuals due to their expertise/experiences.

Applications will be reviewed each calendar quarter, and responses will be sent out a month after the end of each quarter. If you do not hear from us within 1 month after the calendar quarter when your application was sent, then your application was not favourably considered.

## 5.0 CONDITIONS OF FELLOW

The following conditions of the Fellow Programme will hold:

- The fellow will come to the CREAM office and stay for a minimum of 2 working days up to a maximum of 5 working days per month;
- The maximum duration of appointment for the fellow is 1 year, and extensions are on a case-by-case basis, upon consideration by the committee;
- CREAM will provide working space to the fellow, subject to availability;
- Industrial Collaboration Division (BPIP) is assigned to serve as a host for the fellow;
- The fellow will have to deliver talks and special addresses as arranged with CREAM;
- The fellow will interact with CREAM researchers to discuss fresh ideas, strategies, forward-thinking or methodologies on the selected topics and to give advice on ongoing or future research;
- The fellow will publish research papers in related fields and may be requested to submit papers to the MCRJ Journal or other related journals;
- The fellow will provide expertise and access to secure international research grants;
- The fellow will promote CREAM as a leading institution and establish local and international collaboration;
- CREAM will not pay any honorarium/allowances/accommodation/transportation or air tickets during the Fellowship Programme; and
- Fellow is not entitled to participate in medical and dental claims or any other privileges for CREAM's staff.
